HOW TO GET TO PERUGIA by car

Perugia

Perugia is a historic city in central Italy, renowned for its rich cultural heritage, medieval architecture, and vibrant atmosphere. As the capital of the Umbria region, it crowns a hilltop, offering stunning views over the surrounding countryside. The city's well-preserved medieval center features highlights such as the **Palazzo dei Priori**, the **Cathedral of San Lorenzo**, and the **Fontana Maggiore**.

Home to one of Italy's oldest universities, the **University of Perugia**, the city enjoys a youthful, international energy. Perugia is also famous for its cultural events, including the **Umbria Jazz Festival** and the **Eurochocolate Festival**, reflecting its long-standing tradition in chocolate-making. With its charming streets, artistic treasures, and lively cultural scene, Perugia offers visitors a unique blend of history and modernity, making it an unforgettable destination.

From Perugia “San Francesco d'Assisi” Airport

The closest airport is the modest Umbria International Airport (PEG). The airport is located at approximately 17 km from the conference venue, which can be reached with an estimated travel time of 20 – 30 minutes.

From Rome “Leonardo da Vinci” Airport

The main international Italian airport – Leonardo da Vinci – Fiumicino airport (FCO) is located at approximately 200 km from the conference venue, with an estimated travel time to reach the conference venue of 2-3 hours.

Highway A1 del Sole > exit "Orte" (E45-SS3BIS) in the direction of Perugia-Foligno-Assisi until the exit Perugia "Prepo".

From Florence “Amerigo Vespucci” Airport

A. Vespucci Airport in Florence, known as Peretola (FLR), is located at approximately 200 km from the conference venue, with an estimated travel time to reach the conference venue of 2-3 hours.

Coming from the north: Motorway A14 Adriatica > exit Cesena (160 km from Perugia) towards Rome-Perugia (E45SS3BIS) until the exit Perugia "Prepo".

Highway A1 del Sole > exit Valdichiana towards Perugia (E45-SS3BIS) until the exit Perugia "Prepo".

Coming from the south: Highway A14 Adriatica > exit Civitanova Marche towards Foligno-Assisi-Perugia (E45 -SS3BIS) until the exit Perugia "Prepo".



HOW TO GET TO PERUGIA by public transports

From Perugia “San Francesco d’Assisi” Airport

UMBRIA AIRLINK Buses - Umbria Airlink is the service, in collaboration with Trenitalia, that connects the cities of Perugia and Assisi to the international airport of Umbria "San Francesco d'Assisi"¹. The route includes a reduced number of stops to allow the ascent and descent from the airport to the cities of Perugia and Assisi. The stops are easily visible, thanks to the specific graphics of Umbria Airlink. Tickets can be purchased at the airport bar. The routes coincide with the arrivals and departures of flights.
